### Transition Day – Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June

On Transition Day, students will have the opportunity to look around the Academies, meet with staff and other students and sample some of our fantastic lessons.

We will now be providing **all** students with a hot meal for lunch which will be pizza, potato wedges and salad. If your son/daughter would rather bring a packed lunch, they are more than welcome to.
