#### **Cornell Notes**

- Specific topic
- Summarise key information in own words
- Three sections cues/questions (left) notes (right), and summary (bottom)
- Dual coding is great
- Reduced versions nearer to the exam use to self-quiz

#### **Flashcards**

- Question/answer format OR key word/definition format
- Full sentences
- Don't overload the flashcard with lots of information
- Dual coding is great
- Use the waterfall method to self-quiz
