Dear Parents/Carers,

YEAR 7 BOYS RESIDENTIAL TRIP TO BUDDENS ACTIVITY CENTRE 24th – 26th JUNE 2026

The Year 7 team are delighted to be offering your child the opportunity to take part in our new Year 7 residential trip. We will be staying at Buddens Activity Centre, a stunning 96-acre site in Dorset, full of land and water-based activities. The trip is being organised in conjunction with Rockley Adventure, whose activity centres are licensed in the UK by the Adventure Activities Licensing Authority (AALA).

The trip will be a residential visit taking place over three days. The total cost of is £355 per student. This includes return coach travel to Buddens, accommodation for two nights, insurance, all day activities and equipment, evening entertainment, as well as breakfast, lunch and evening meals.

Within the centre's vast array of fields, we have some idyllic tented villages. The tented villages are made up of 5/6 metre bell tents for pupils and adults alike. They come complete with metal framed beds and comfortable mattresses with a cover sheet, so all the hard work has been taken care of.

The programme of activities organised by Rockley Adventure will include the likes of Climbing, Zip Wire, Jacobs Ladder, Leap of Faith, MEGA SUP, Stand Up Paddle Boarding, Kayaking, Canoeing, Archery and Axe Throwing to name just a few.

To gain a place on the trip, parents/carers need to fill in the Microsoft form, which **will go live on Monday 20th October at 6pm**: <https://forms.office.com/e/N9QuCS6pJQ>

Places will then be granted as per our policy and a confirmation letter with the schedule for payments will be sent out. A reserve list will be generated based on demand. A deposit of £55 is required and will be launched on ParentPay **once spaces are confirmed** (to set up an account if you don't already have one, please email bmthpoolefinance@unitedlearning.org.uk including your child's full name and year group), details will be provided in the letter sent confirming your child's place. Payments will only be refunded in exceptional circumstances or if insufficient numbers are obtained. The rest of the balance will be due in instalments and paid in full by the end of March 2026. We will hold an information evening for the trip later in the academic year.
