BRONZE DUKE OF EDINBURGH AWARD 2024/25

We are thoroughly looking forward to getting our Bronze Duke of Edinburgh Award up and running for the 2024/25 academic year.

The Duke of Edinburgh award is an internationally recognised award that helps students beyond their academic achievements. It helps students develop their commitment, leadership, teamwork and communication skills whilst also being great fun to take part in.

Principle dates:

- Training Day (in school): Thursday 1st May 2025
- Practice Expedition: Friday 2nd Saturday 3rd May 2025 **Please note students will need to be dropped off and collect from the venue (TBC) in the New Forest by parents.**
- Qualifying expedition: 3rd 4th July 2025 **Please note students will need to be dropped off and collect from the venue (TBC) in the Purbecks by parents.**

If you are interested in completing your Bronze Award with us, the total cost is £240 per student. This covers the DofE enrolment cost, the training, practice and qualifying expedition with Land and Wave and use of the provided kit.

To secure your space on the DofE Award, please pay a deposit of £40 by **Friday 29th November 2024.** Once the deposits have been paid, this secures your space and you must pay the remaining balance. Refunds cannot be given.
